


# Newsletter from WBFSH secretariat Vilhelmsborg, December 6<sup>th</sup> 2016

### Transport

The shuttle between the Best Western Hotel, the Palexpo and the airport will go endlessly every day, but it is also used by the other guests of the hotel going to and from the airport.

From the airport to the Palexpo (CHI-Geneva takes place there) - approx. 5 minutes.

From Palexpo to the Best Western hotel – approx. 10 minutes.

Parking – if going by car: Park your car at the Best Western Chavannes-de-Bogis and take the shuttle to the Palexpo.

in a reasonable way, therefore for Saturday a special bus for up to 50 people is booked.

The schedules of this WBFSH bus between Palexpo and Best Western Hotel on Saturday December 10<sup>th</sup> will be:

- 11.00 leaving Best Western
- 12.45 leaving Palexpo
- 17.00 leaving Best Western
- 22.30 leaving Palexpo



The bus is for free.

Sunday afternoon:

Apart from the endless shuttle service, a bus is also booked to bring the delegates to Palexpo, leaving Best Western at 13.45. The bus will leave Palexpo at the end of the show (17.00) and drive through the town; that Sunday in Geneva there will be the "escalade" procession through the old town (with horses!). The bus will stop for the delegates to watch the procession and drive them back to the hotel at 19.00.

Tired delegates who want to leave earlier or just not go along and see the escalade will have to take a shuttle or a taxi.

#### **Cocktail receptions on Saturday – when and where?**

- 11.30-12.30 The Rolex cocktail reception is held in the Jappeloup Lounge\*  
A max of 40 people are invited to this, and you can see on the participant list who can attend. The delegates invited will get a special invitation card to show at the entrance of the Jappeloup area.
- 11.30-12.30 Cocktail reception at the ZVCH booth no. 86 in the exhibition village of the CHI; all others not going to the Rolex reception are invited.
- 18.00-19.00 Cocktail offered by the ZVCH in the Jappeloup Lounge\* - where delegates can stay to view the Rolex/WBFSH Awards Ceremony followed by the buffet dinner.

#### **\*How to find "Espace Jappeloup"?**

Everybody who are signed up will have an invitation (included in their envelope with the badge); this invitation is needed to get in; the attendants at the entrance will show the people where they have to go (straight on) towards the "accueil VIP"; there they will get a bracelet allowing them to go to the "espace Jappeloup". A hostess will bring them from the "accueil VIP" to the "espace Jappeloup" ("espace Jappeloup" is located close to the "jockey club" and "jump off"). There will be stairs to climb.

#### **Workshop groups Tuesday**

The overview of the 5 workshop groups will be online in a few days and like previous years it will be shown on an outline at the wall of the workshop meeting room.

There will be 1 Non-European group and 4 groups with European participants, each with a moderator like previous years. We kindly encourage you to consider which project for a you would like to suggest in your workshop group.


