



WBFSH- World Championships for International Young Breeders 2013 in Sweden

The Swedish Warmblood Association will host the WBFSH World Championships of International Young Breeders in Bollerup, on July 12th and 13th 2013.

All horse breeding federations who are member of the WBFSH are invited to send their young people (aged 16-25) to take part in these championships. It will not be necessary to bring their own horses since all horses will be provided by the Bollerup Equine College.

Teams will arrive on Friday morning and after a welcoming lunch the competition starts with a theory exam, then the judging of the loose jumping, followed by a show programme featuring Swedish horses and riders. After dinner the evening will finish with a presentation of all the teams and lots of entertaining activities.

On Saturday the championships will continue with a test of skills in preparing horses for show, the judging of exterior qualities (conformation) and movement (paces) and as well assessment of how the competitors present the horse in-hand .

The prizegiving ceremony will take place during the party on Saturday evening. All competitors, their supports, trainers, officials and families are then invited on Sunday to visit the famous Falsterbo Horse Show. On Monday there will also be an option to joining an organised tour to some of Sweden's best known studfarms.
